LITITZ, Pa. (December 1, 2018) – We all know and love Lititz Springs Park, especially the scenic towering trees which provide lots of shade in the summertime for various activities and outdoor play. However, once summer turns to fall, those leaves change to their beautiful autumn colors and ultimately start falling... and falling....and falling.
